

MAPLE RIDGE CORRIDOR STUDY

The Maple Ridge Road Corridor Study is evaluating the Maple Ridge Road Corridor from Salt Works Road to Bates Road through the Town of Shelby and Village of Medina. Maple Ridge Road serves as a major connector between towns in this region of Western New York. The Village sits nearly halfway between the cities of Buffalo and Rochester; a 44 mile drive and 43 mile drive respectively.

An analysis of the existing conditions along the roadway in this area will help inform the recommendations that reflect the needs and desires of all users so that Maple Ridge Road can become a safer route for walking, biking, and driving.

Public input is an integral part of the planning process and will help us develop a strategy that is responsive to local values and concerns.
